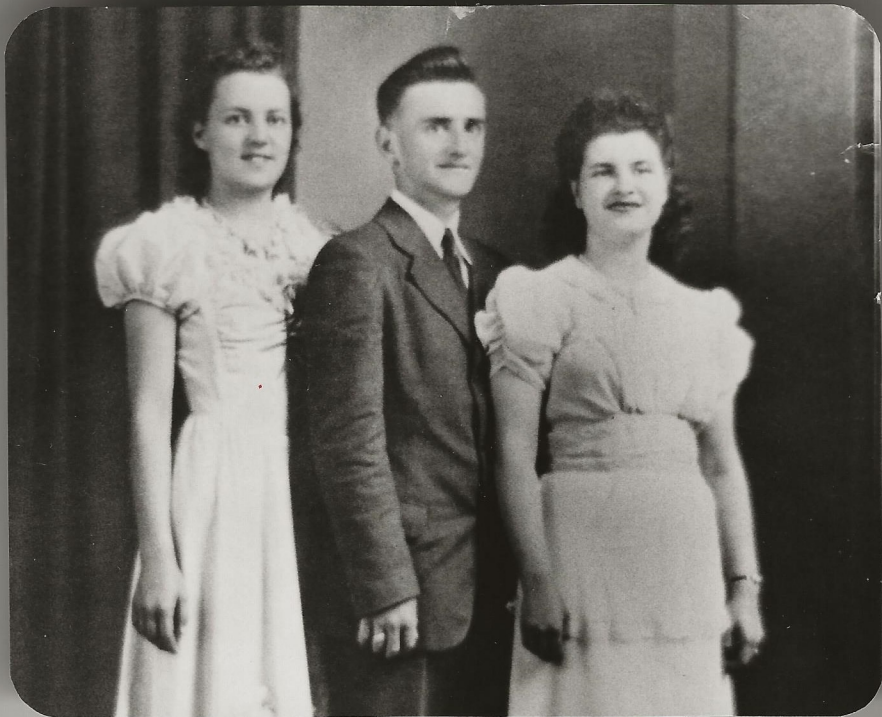

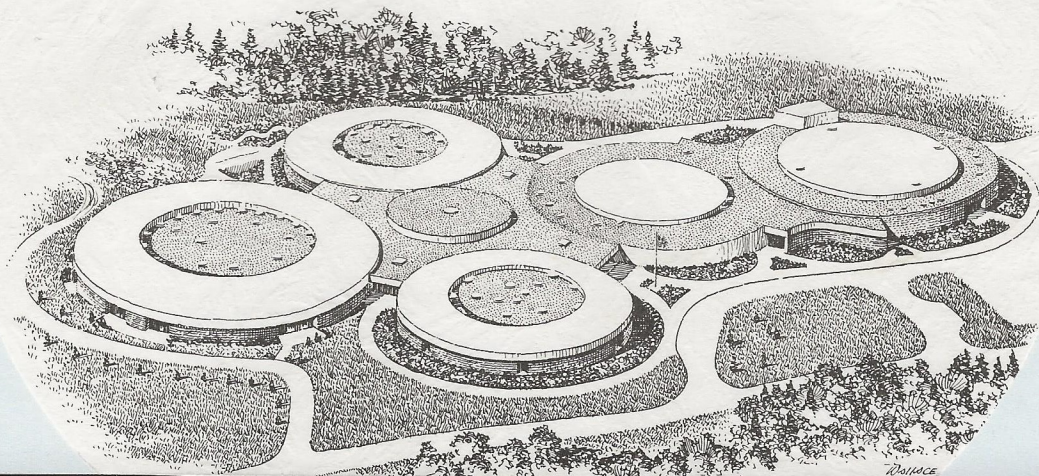

Franklin, June 9.—The new high school building will be dedicated Tuesday afternoon, June 14, at 2 o'clock. The program will consist of brief speeches by Principal E. S. Boyd, A. D. Horskins, and others. State Superintendent of Education Mason S. Stone will deliver the principal address.

A feature of the exercises will be an exhibit of the work done by all the grades during the past year.

The public will be invited to inspect the work exhibited and the building and its equipment.

### SCHOOL BUILDING DEDICATED.

Up-to-Date Structure at Franklin  
Opened with Fitting Exercises.

(Special to The Messenger.)

Franklin, June 14.—The new high school building which was erected at a cost of \$8,000 by C. C. Sunderland, of St. Albans, contractor, was dedicated yesterday with appropriate exercises.

The building is a up-to-date structure 42x55 feet and two stories high, with basement. Steam heat is conveyed to every room above the basement in which are the toilet, boiler, and two play rooms.

The play grounds are in the rear of the building and contain three acres which have been graded and rolled, making a large and commodious baseball diamond.

The program of the day was as follows:

Invocation, the Rev. F. Wilson Day. Singing, M. E. Shedd, G. H. Anderson, F. L. Hopkins, F. C. and A. D. Whitney.

Opening address, Edwin S. Boyd, principal of the high school, subject, "The High School and the Community".

The Hon. C. W. Gates, state highway commissioner, and E. J. Best, of Enosburg Falls, superintendent of schools, then each delivered an interesting and instructive address.

Address, "The Function of Schools", State Superintendent of Education Mason S. Stone, of Enosburg Falls.

The addresses were listened to with the closest attention.

The exercises proper were concluded by singing, followed by an informal inspection of the exhibits of the work done during the past school year, showing such marked improvement that Principal Boyd can rest assured that he has the support of the people in his efforts to upbuild and strengthen the educational element of the town. Mr. Boyd has been re-engaged as principal for the ensuing year.
